Prepare



Start by cleansing the wound in accordance with normal procedures and make sure the surrounding skin is completely dry before application

Select an appropriate dressing size the wound by at least 1-2 cm.



Open the sterile packaging and remove the dressing



Do not stretch the dressing while applying and avoid wrinkles

Apply



1. Remove the outer release film (purple bar)



2. Apply dressing to wound and smooth border



3. Repeat on other side and smooth dressing into place

3" x 3" and 4" x 4" 6"x 6" and 6" x 8"



1. Remove the central part of the release film (two purple bars)



2. Apply dressing to the wound



3. Release each side film and smooth dressing into place

Maintain

0 Sides



Strikethrough at 0 edges. Can keep in place

1 Side



Strikethrough at 1 edge. Can keep in place

2 Sides



Strikethrough at 2 edges. Can keep in place

3 Sides



- The dressing may be left in place for up to 7 days
- Inspect the dressing and skin daily
- Leave the dressing on unless there are clinical reasons to change
- Change the dressing
- If exudate leaks from the dressing or into the borders
- If there is any sign of infection
- When the dressing is fully saturated (exudate reaches 3 out of 4 sides

Frequency of change

Mepilex Border Flex may be left in place up to 7 days, depending on the condition of the wound and surrounding skin, or as indicated by accepted clinical practice.

Areas of use

Mepilex Border Flex is designed for a wide range of acute and chronic wounds such as leg and foot ulcers, pressure ulcers, traumatic wounds and skin tears. It can also be used on dry/necrotic wounds in combination with gels.

Precautions

In the case of signs of clinical infection, consult a healthcare professional for adequate infection treatment. Do not use on patients with known sensitivity to the dressing or its components.
